The Community Coach Accreditation was developed to build on the knowledge developed during the Introduction to Coaching and Junior Coach modules for coaches to create and develop their own training sessions.

During the two-hour face-to-face course coaches will have the opportunity to collaborate with others and build on the areas they would like to develop more skill or expertise in. The course is primarily hands on practical session development.

Step 1

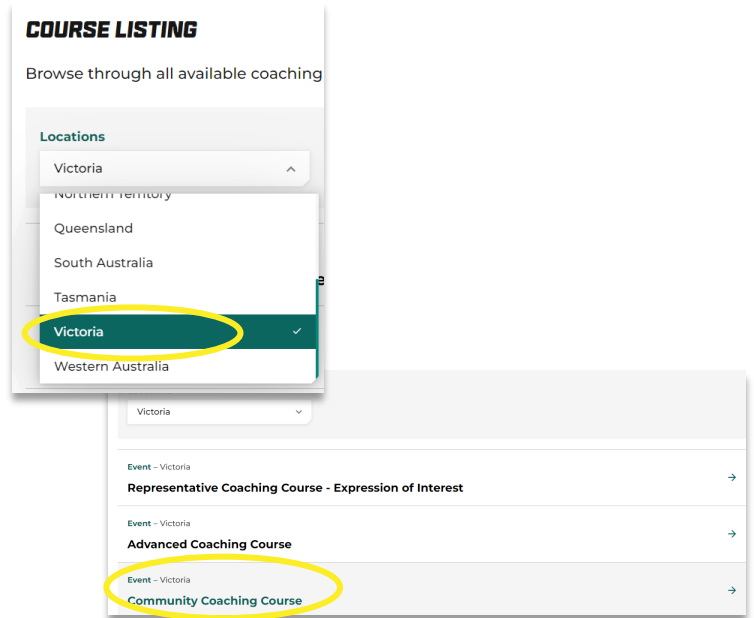
To begin, [click here](#) or visit PlayCricket Coach home page, select Coach Development followed by Courses on side menu.



Step 2

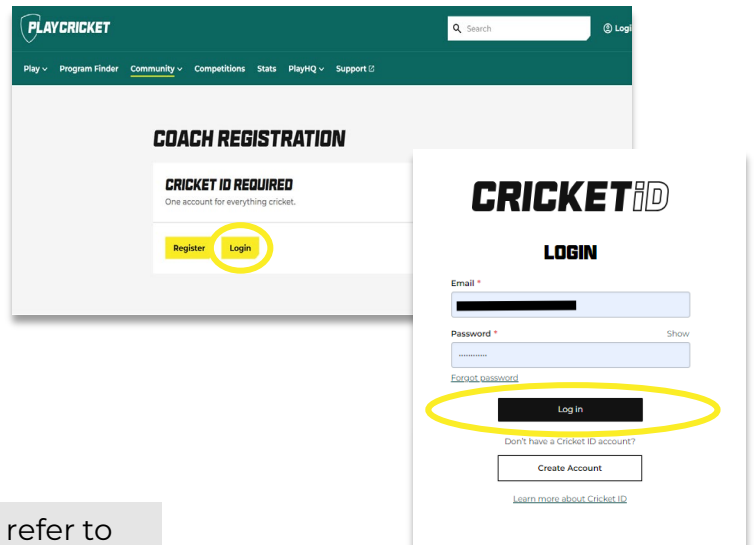
Click on the drop-down menu, select your State or Territory.

Select **Login** and follow the prompts to complete the login process.

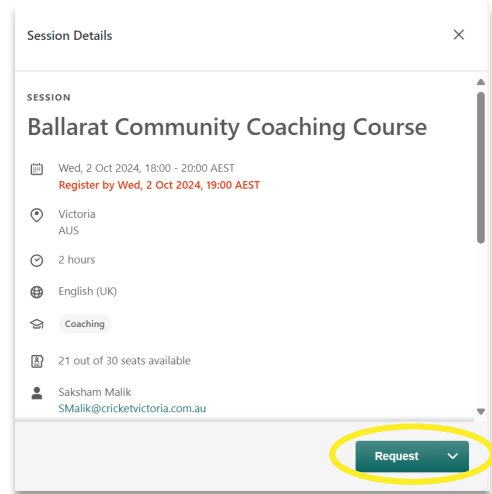
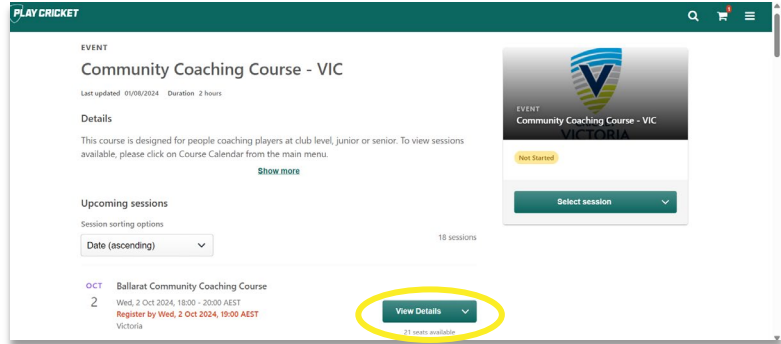


If haven't created a Cricket ID, please refer to the help guide **Registering as a Coach**.

Find the course date and location, you would like to attend and click **View Details**

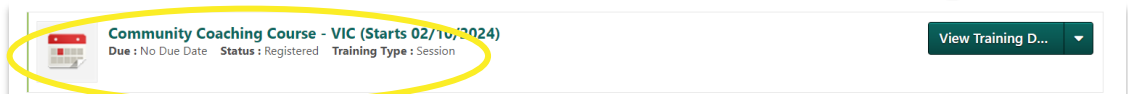
Read through the details of the course and select **Request** to register for the course.



Step 5

Once you're successfully registered, you'll see the course listed in your **Training Record** with the status **Registered**.

You'll also receive a confirmation email.



Step 6

In the lead up to the course, expect to receive communication from your State or Territory with relevant information about the course day.

Step 7

Following the course, the course administrator will mark your attendance in the Learning Management System.

Once this step has been completed, you will receive an email confirming you have completed your **Community Coach Accreditation!**
